How to host your Unite Event in five easy steps!

1. Complete the POC Appointment Letter

Squadron Commanders will complete the Unite POC appointment letter and return to the C3.

The POC Appointment Letter is available upon request.

45 DAYS PRIOR TO EVENT

2. Event Proposal

Squadron POC submits Event Planning Worksheet to C3 for review to discuss the event objectives.

35 DAYS PRIOR TO EVENT

3. Submit Request Form

Squadron POC submits Event Request form signed by squadron commander to the C3.

Note: The Squadron commander's signature acknowledges that he/she is aware of the event and how the allocations are being spent.

4. Purchases

Once event is approved from AFSVC the C3 will coordinate with squadron POC to schedule purchases and pay for event expenses.

5 DAYS AFTER EVENT COMPLETION

5. Have Fun at Your Event

Squadron POC will provide an overview of the success of the event and/or lessons learned.

FAQs

Does Unite funding include AiTs?

No, funding is only for Active Duty, Permanent Party, Reserve, Civilians (APF & NAF)

Can a unit use both APF and NAF funds together for an event?

Yes! APF dollars are used for the program and NAF dollars are used for the purchase of food and beverage.

Can Unite just cover food?

No. The NAF dollars must be used in conjuction with the APF dollars.

Can families be included?

Yes, however funding does not cover families.

Can we use the money to pay for retirements or change of commands?

No. This money is only to be used to build unit cohesion and squadron morale. Not authorized for ceremonies or other official functions.

Contact Resource Management about SM&W funds.

Who all can use the Unite Funds?

Active Duty, Civilians (APF & NAF), and Reserve Units.

Does Funding change as squadron numbers increase/decrease?

No. Funding is set from the squadron's end strength from the previous fiscal year.

How do I find out how much money a squadron has?

Squadron POC and/or CC can contact the C3 for available funds.

Ready to Execute (RTE)

Participation Costs

Activity, supplies, equipment rentals, decorations, etc.

Funds CANNOT be used for prizes

\$5.00 (NAF)

Food Allowance

Food and non alcoholic beverage.

Must be used in conjunction with APF

Unite funds CANNOT be used for holiday parties.

Units are responsible for expenses that exceed the allotted Unite amount.

Unite funds run from January -December.

Family members are welcome to participate, but must pay any associated fees.
